#### **Prince Edward County - RoseHall Run Vineyards Inc.**

Bordering Lake Ontario and the Bay of Quinte, this appellation is surrounded by water and features a rich terroir dominated by stony soils. It's also home to some of North America's largest freshwater beaches. Discover stunning wineries, perfectly situated throughout Prince Edward County and renowned for their award-winning vintages. Enhance your experience with farm-fresh produce, regional cuisine, charming boutiques and spas, and artisanal studios.

#### **Niagara Escarpment - Tawse Winery/Flat Rock Cellars**

First-time visitors are often astonished at the breathtaking, natural beauty of the Niagara Escarpment, one of two appellations within the Niagara Peninsula, which stretches west of St. Catharines to Grimsby along the shores of Lake Ontario. Tour this unique area with a visit to one of our many various wineries. It is a great opportunity to taste its distinctive award-winning wines and sample culinary delights crafted from an abundance of local, farm-fresh produce.



**TAWSE WINERY**

Two beautiful yet distinctively different vineyards located along the gentle slopes of the Niagara Escarpment. Cherry Road Vineyard is situated on the Twenty Mile Bench and Quarry Road Vineyard is on the Vinemount Ridge. Sustainable farming practices and gravity-fed winery are used in both and go a long way in producing exquisite wines. Tawse Winery was named one of the top ten wineries in Canada at the 2008 Canadian Wine award!

Pascal Marchand, a Canadian who lived in France for over 20 years is an internationally renowned winemaker, and brings his extensive experience and in-depth knowledge of Burgundy wines to Tawse Vineyards. Winemaker Paul Pender, part of the Tawse winemaking team is creative and passionate as he works to produce some of Ontario's finest wines.

#### **2006 ECHOS WHITE, VQA NIAGARA PENINSULA VQA \$46.95 for 750 ml**

Hand leaf-plucked and hand harvested this Chardonnay is pale straw in colour and presents aromas of fresh, sweet apples with a hint of almond and an underlying sur lie complexity in the mid palate. Restrained use of new oak has crafted a wine which accentuates fruit with a fresh, crisp finish.

#### **TAWSE 2008, MISEK VINEYARD, OFF-DRY RIESLING \$49.95 for 750 ml**

This Off-Dry Riesling is sourced from old vines located 'On the Bench', in the Twenty Mile Bench VQA sub-appellation.

The Winemaker tells us the nose on this Riesling is ripe and complex. With bright peach and apricot overtones, the undertones of minerality and beeswax hint at the clean and crisp palate that awaits. Refreshing fruit notes blend seamlessly with just a hint of honey and the balanced acidity leads to a long and satisfying finish.

#### **2007 PINOT NOIR \$79.95 for 750 ml**

The Winemaker tells us this hand-harvested wine offers a hint of spice and vanilla underlies the bright, ripe cherry notes on the nose of this Pinot Noir. On the palate, the plush red fruit continues with a mild smoky note adding complexity. The round tannins and clean acidity lend this wine balance and the wine closes with a long, warm finish.

**FLAT ROCK  
CELLARS**

Located on the Niagara Escarpment known as the Jordan Bench and the upper Vineland Bench. Flat Rock is perched on a gently rolling slope studded with vines with a state-of-the-art winemaking facility. The vineyard has breathtaking views of the Peninsula and across Lake Ontario to Toronto. Flat Rock Cellars work diligently to protect the delicate eco-systems contained on and around the vineyard and surrounding community. Marlize Beyers is the dynamic Winemaker who has worked on vintages in some of the world's finest wine regions, including Bordeaux, South Africa and Germany. Her diverse experience and well-rounded knowledge allow her to pull out all the stops in order for the Flat Rock wines to reach their maximum potential.

#### **2006 Red Twisted, VQA Niagara Peninsula VQA \$45.95 for 750 ml**

This is an exciting wine...the blend is 74.6% Pinot Noir, 23.6 % Syrah and here's the 'twist' ...1.8% Chardonnay! A serious and delicious 'twist' waiting to be enjoyed. Look for medium body with bright cherry fruit and plum and a floral and earthiness on the nose. Lively, well balanced acidity and hints of spice on the palate.

#### **2005 Riesling, VQA Twenty Mile Bench VQA \$56.95 for 750 ml**

You will notice a lovely pale straw colour in this handpicked and hand sorted Riesling. It is light and lemony with a floral nose and has a mid-palate dominated by grapefruit with some sweetness to balance the citrus acidity.

#### **2003 Pinot Noir, VQA Niagara Peninsula VQA \$56.95 for 750 ml**

This lovely Pinot Noir is a blend of two Dijon clones grown in vineyards directly in front of the Winery and Cellar Door. The aromas show a complex mix of red fruits, spice and hints of earthiness and are well balanced by the backbone of natural acidity. It has a finish showing ripe tannins and an underlying complexity that provides exceptional length.



PRINCE EDWARD COUNTY is an unspoiled island, located in Southern Ontario in the Bay of Quinte, Lake Ontario. This rural landscape is full of charm and produces beautiful wines. Rosehall Run Vineyard is named after the charming hamlet of Rosehall. Dan Sullivan is the vine-to-vine, hands-on Grand Master Winemaker receiving constant positive press for his estate-grown wines.

We are proud to showcase three outstanding wines from Rosehall Run.

#### **2007 SULLYZWICKER, VQA PRINCE EDWARD COUNTY \$45.95 for 750 ml**

A blend of Ehrenfeller, Riesling, and Muscat. Slightly off-dry with lots of citrus fruit as well as apple and pear notes. Delicious and pleasant with a refreshing acidity on the palate. Won the Bronze, Artevino County Wine Competition, 2008.

#### **2007 SULLYZWICKER RED, VQA PRINCE EDWARD COUNTY \$35.95 for 750 ml**

A blend of Gamay/Cabernet Franc/Pinot Noir. Hand-harvested, this partially aged wine has sweet smoky notes with a lively, medium-body, bright fruit flavour and soft tannins. A proud winner of the Bronze award from Finger Lakes International Wine Competition

#### **2007 CABERNET FRANC, Cuvée County, VQA Prince Edward County \$45.95 for 750 ml**

Rosehall says "most of the Franc was barreled into small French cooperage with a smattering of American Oak to add a little plushness."

"Light bright ruby colour and slightly perfumed, with berry-plum fruit, violet, tobacco and bark-mulch earthiness. Mild tannin and some warmth with very good length" are some comments from David Lawrason, educator and wine competition judge as well as wine columnist for Toronto Life. This wine is a Bronze winner of Finger Lakes International Competition.
